**Lorstat (atorvastatin (as calcium trihydrate)), 10 mg & 80 mg, film-coated tablets (TT50-9651, c)**

Viatriis Ltd would like to inform you of the following:

Due to a supply shortage of Lorstat (atorvastatin (as calcium trihydrate)) film-coated tablets, products packed for the Australian market were recently supplied to New Zealand.

Whilst the Australian product is packed in a blister pack, the tablets are otherwise identical to the New Zealand product and is also registered for use in New Zealand.

The labelling for the Australian packaging was recently registered with Medsafe, however the Australian carton included a storage condition to discard 30 days after the first tablet is taken – see labelling overleaf.

There is no requirement stated in the New Zealand registration (or requested by Medsafe) to discard the pack 30 days after the first tablet is taken and the product is fully stable within the blister packaging for the duration of the registered shelf-life.
